Sovereign Design Play Systems Ltd inspectors are accredited to the (Register of Play Inspectors International) and are qualified to carry out operational inspections on your behalf, for both Sovereign and other manufacturers play equipment.

Operational inspections should be carried out at intervals not exceeding 3 months in unsupervised areas.
