- 1. 2yo bare root Red Fallstaff apple tree on M9 dwarf rootstock. Max height 3m.
- 2. 3yo bare root Lapin cherry tree on Colt rootstock. Max height 3m
- 3. 2yo bare root Jubilee plum on St Julien rootstock. Max height 3m.
- 4. 2yo bare root Bramley apple on M9 dwarf rootstock. Max height 3m.

I've carefully placed the trees as to not overshadow either the neighbouring plot or the existing beds on my plot. I hope this is ok!
