Councillor Filmer reported thar numbers are falling in the County of Corona virus cases and the vaccine programme is running well. Over 200,000 vaccines have been given. County has set the budget, the rise in Council tax will be 4.99%, 2% for County and 2.99% for social care. £400,000 has been budgeted to Citizen Advice.

The Unitary debate continues, and the consultation is until April. Parish and Town Councils have not been consulted and they are encouraged to do so. County elections have been deferred until next year.

Councillor Lane is applying to Hinkley Point for a grant, evidence will be required for match funding. The clerk will provide feedback on funds available for this after the year end.
