Nick Morphet advised the gully truck that operates on a 32month cycle is to be in the Humshaugh ward in the coming months

Clerk asked by a PC member to enquire when the road sweeper will next be in Birtley

Paul Andrew advised a cheque has been banked from the resilience committee of Northern Electric which will finance the gas powered generator and other equipment required for its operation

The new access ramp to the hall to enable mobility scooters access has been installed the handrail been ordered

The committee has asked Peter Milburn to quote for the cost of a new gate for the entrance of the play park

It was suggested the cost and installation be paid 50 -50 by the Parish Council and the Town hall committee

Paul Andrew confirmed he had uploaded photographs from the event to the NCC archive
