3.1	<p><u>Benches:</u> On Green Gates, the school has offered to repair those originally made by the school. BL to transfer £604.78 to pay for material.</p> <p>THC has clarified that the pavement/verge on the road between Fortrose and Rosemarkie is not wide enough to accommodate a mid-way bench.</p> <p>It was noted that THC has said no more memorial benches will be permitted on Marine Terrace or Chanonry Point.</p>	
3.2	<p><u>Phone Boxes:</u> Following correspondence with BT, HA said that only older phone boxes of historical interest, such as the K6 style by Fortrose Post Office, can be adopted and adapted for community purposes. More modern styles can only be adopted if they are to be used to house a defibrillator. BT will cover electricity costs for the first 7 years only.</p>
