MUGA approval with 5 year guarantee, works to commence at a date to be agreed with DCM. It was agreed unanimously to carry on with this as per the original proposal with the 5 year guarantee which is stated as industry standard. LP to contact DCM to confirm and get start date.

Key workers tree planting - 5th July NHS and frontline workers day for discussion. 5th July would be a good day to plant a tree providing the epidemic is at an end. Re table for April **Facebook update** – LP AND LIM attended a NALC training course regarding Council use of social media. It was clear that a policy of how it is to be used is needed and it was decided to put that in place before carrying on with inviting the local businesses to come online. **Heddon PC website**. – We are looking to migrate to the new Spanglefish site by the end of February.
