23/0026 Apologies

Apologies had been received from Cllr Spillane and the reason for absence was **ACCEPTED**.

23/0027 Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest.

23/0028 Minutes

a) Full Council Meeting minutes dated 1<sup>st</sup> November 2022 – **APPROVED** and signed by Cllr Day as a true record.

23/0029 Open session for the public

There were no items brought for discussion under this item.

23/0030 Matters arising from the Full Council Meeting 1<sup>st</sup> November 2022

- a) Queens platinum jubilee bench – The Clerk updated the council that they were still waiting for quotes to come through for the base for the bench. It was **AGREED** that this item would be brought back to the next meeting.
- b) New Litter Bins - The Clerk updated the council that they were still waiting for information to come back from the relevant department. It was **AGREED** that this item would be brought back to the next meeting.

23/0031                      Agenda Items Not Covered Elsewhere

- a) Grant request from All Saints Church – All Saints Church have requested a grant of £1000, it was **AGREED** to give the requested grant.
- b) New Councillor – Teri Browett gave a brief presentation, and it was **AGREED** that she would be co-opted onto the Council by a show of hands, signed the Declaration of Acceptance of office in the presence of the Clerk and joined the meeting.
- c) Stanton-on-the-Wolds Parish Council postal address – Keyworth Parish Council have agreed to allow Stanton-on-the-Wolds Parish Council to use their Council office as the postal address for the fee of £35 per year. It was **AGREED** that Stanton-on-the-Wolds Parish Council would pay the £35 annual fee and use the Keyworth Parish Council Office as their postal address.
- d) Kings Coronation - With the King having his coronation this year, it was **AGREED** that the Parish Council place some planter boxes at each of the signs as you enter the village. Each box would have plants that are red, white, and blue and a plaque would be placed on each box to commemorate the King. It further **AGREED** that the clerk would investigate if anything could be purchased for the lampposts similar to the poppies that are used in November.
- e) Stanton-on-the-Wolds newsletter – Since the COVID pandemic there hasn't been a regular newsletter that is delivered to the houses of the village. It was **AGREED** that the Clerk will contact the Keyworth News to see how many houses in Stanton-on-the-Wolds already receive the Keyworth News and ask if those houses that don't could be included in the round. If the Keyworth News can include all houses in Stanton-on-the-Wolds, it was also **AGREED** the Clerk will investigate how much it will cost for Stanton-on-the-Wolds Parish Council to have a couple of pages in the Keyworth News to keep residents updated. It was further **AGREED** that the Clerk will set up a Facebook page as another way of trying to keep local residents up to date with information.
