

**MINUTES OF STANTON-ON-THE-WOLDS PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD IN THE PARISH

23/0036 Apologies

Apologies had been received from Cllr Rahman and the reason for absence was **ACCEPTED**.

23/0037 Declarations of interest

There were no declarations of interest.

23/0038 Minutes

- a. Full Council Meeting minutes dated 3rd January 2023 – **APPROVED** and signed by Cllr Day as a true record.

23/0039 Open session for the public

There were no items brought for discussion under this item.

Cllr Spillane arrived during this item.

23/0040 Matters arising from the Full Council Meeting 3rd January 2023

- a. Queens platinum jubilee bench – It was **AGREED** that the Clerk will write to Willow Brook school to make sure they are happy for a bench to be placed on the grass verg outside of the school. It was also **AGREED** that the Clerk will write to Cllr Cottee to ask for his backing on the project. The RFO also updated Council to say we are applying for a grant to go towards the cost of the bench.
- b. New litter bins – The Clerk informed the council that Streetwise are going to do an assessment to determine litter levels. It was **CONFIRMED** the bin locations need to be in the layby opposite 126 Melton Road at the end of footpath number 6 and footpath

number 7. The second bin has been **CONFIRMED** to be located opposite number 138 Browns Lane, this is at the intersection of footpath number 12.

- c. Kings Coronation planter boxes – It was **AGREED** that the cost of the planter boxes will be about £300. The Borough Councillor advised that the Parish Council can ask the new Borough Councillor for a grant towards the cost of the planter boxes.
- d. Stanton-on-the-Wolds newsletter – The Clerk updated the Council that contact had been made with the Keyworth News and a further update will be brought back to the next meeting.

23/0041 Agenda items not covered elsewhere

- a. Storage unit at recent barn conversion – It was **AGREED** that the Clerk will write to Rushcliffe Borough Council as the storage unit is a violation of condition ten in the terms and conditions of the planning application.
- b. Information on the Parish Council elections – The Clerk gave a verbal update of the elections that are happening in May. The Clerk **CONFIRMED** that if Council Members would like her to take their application form in, they would need to get the form to the Clerk by the end of the day on Wednesday the 29th March 2023.

23/0042 Finance

- a. A schedule of payments and reimbursements included in the briefing notes for the meeting was **APPROVED** for payment (appendix 1).
- b. The Asset register included in the briefing notes for the meeting was **APPROVED** (appendix 2).
- c. NS&I Account - RFO gave a verbal update on the NS&I account, it was **AGREED** that once access was gained to the NS&I account, the funds would be moved over to the Natwest current account.

23/0043 Planning applications

- a. 23/00048/FUL – Land and building at Browns Lane, Stanton-on-the-Wolds – **NO OBJECTION**

23/0044 Correspondence items not covered elsewhere

- a. Reduced visibility at the junction of Browns Lane and Melton Road. – **NOTED** – The Parish Council will have a word with the owner of the car wash to see if they can adjust the position of the sign.
- b. Objection to planning application 23/00048/FUL – **NOTED**

Borough Cllr Edyvean updated council members with information that Rushcliffe Borough Council will not be increasing precepts for the year 2023 / 2024, they will also remain debt free. Furthermore, Cllr Edyvean confirmed that one million pounds is to be split between Keyworth and Cotgrave Leisure Centres for refurbishments and updates.
