Matters Arising from Full Council Meeting 7th November 2023

- a) Queens Platinum Jubilee Bench – The quote for the bench base from Cotgrave Civils was **REVIEWED** and **RATIFIED**. The quote came to £1100.00 plus VAT, plus a permit charge of £117.00.
- b) History Board – It was **AGREED** that Council would like to look at two places to place history boards, these would be on the corner of Browns Lane and Thurlby Lane and the second one would be on Willow Brook. - a) 23/02214/FUL – 48a Stanton Lane, Stanton-on-the-Wolds - **RESOLVED – OBJECT**
 - The Parish council notes that the installation has already taken place of the air source heat pump, and this is not a retrospective planning application.
 - The Parish Council is unsure how the pump will be maintained without encroaching onto the neighbouring property as it is very close to the boundary line.
 - If the plans are passed, then the Parish Council would like assurances that the pump has been installed at the correct distance from the boundary line.
