24/0100 Apologies

Apologies were received from Cllr Browett and the reason for absence was **ACCEPTED**.
County and Borough Cllrs Cottee and Wells also sent their apologies.

24/0101 Declarations of Interest

24/0102 Minutes

a) Annual Parish Council Meeting minutes dated 7th May 2024 – **APPROVED** and signed by
Cllr Day as a true record.

24/0103 Open Session for the Public

24/0104 County and Borough Council Updates

Councillor Inglis let the Parish council know that Cllr Cottee has taken the request for 30mph
speed limit on the corner of Browns Lane and Stanton Lane to the road safety team. He will

24/0105 Matters Arising from Full Council Meeting 7th November 2023

- a) Queens Platinum Jubilee Bench – Cotgrave Civils have confirmed they are having a slight
issue with the permit required for the work. The Clerk will keep chasing for the work to
be carried out.
- b) History Board – It was **AGREED** that the Clerk will contact the editor of the Keyworth
News to see if they can help with the designing of the history boards. The Clerk will also

contact the email address that Cllr Healy provided for the university to see if they have any capacity to be able to help.

- a) Raised Bed – It was **AGREED** that the Council will ask the gardener to weed and maintain the raised bed on the corner of Browns Lane and Stanton Lane.
- b) Litter – The litter at the side of the roads has been removed with the recent grass cutting. It was **AGREED** that the Parish Council will advise in the Keyworth News about the possibility of a litter pick.
- c) Provision of Bulbs – It was **AGREED** that the Parish Council will spend £50 on bulbs and distribute to households who are willing to plant them in a place on their property where members of the public will be able to see them.
- d) Potholes - It was **AGREED** that if anyone spots any potholes in the Village, they will report them on the my Notts app or on the Nottinghamshire County Council website.
