25/0152 Apologies

25/0154 Co-option of a New Councillor

Angela Benney was proposed and duly elected as a new Parish Councillor. Angela signed her declaration of acceptance and joined the remainder of the meeting.

25/0155 Minutes

a) Full Council Meeting minutes dated 5th November 2024 – **APPROVED** and signed by Cllr Day as a true record.

25/0156 Open Session for the Public

Cllr Browett arrived during this item.

A member of the public, brought along the Stanton Cup which he won recently at a local show, to see if anyone knew the history of the cup. It was first awarded to Mrs E Hutton in 1983. The Clerk will put on the website to see if anyone local knows about the history of the cup. The Clerk will also look back to the minuets from 1983 to see if there is any mention of the cup.

A member of the public raised concerns about the speed that cars travel on Stanton Lane, they were informed that unfortunately this has been brought up before, but the section of road has not seen enough dangerous accidents for the County Council to look at reducing the speed.

Furthermore, there was a conversation about the hedge on the corner of Willow Brook and Stanton Lane and that it is protruding into the pavement making it hard for people to pass by while walking and with pushchairs. It was **AGREED** that the Clerk will report the problem on the Nottinghamshire County Council website.

- c) Linkup Path between Public footpath14 and the pavement outside 206 Melton Road – A petition with 204 signatures has been handed over to Cllr Cottee. Cllr Cottee will now take the petition and present the case to the County Council. The other Council members thanked Cllr Danielson for his diligent efforts to procure the petition.
