Centrebus – The Nottingham to Melton Mowbray service has been reinstated. The number 19 bus operates four times per day along the A606 Melton Road. Copies of the timetable can be found online or are available from the Parish Office.

Nottsbuses on demand – This is a new service which will replace the current 853 service, that runs from Hickling Pastures to West Bridgford via Browns Lane and Stanton Lane. From the 22nd July 2024 a bus can be booked in advance by either downloading the app or calling 0115 8040404.
