Parish Council Meeting - The Parish Council met on Tuesday 2nd September. Four Parish Councillors, two Borough Councillors and one resident attended with the Parish Clerk and Finance Officer. There was a full agenda including an update on Tree Preservation Orders (TPOs) within the village. Full details can be viewed on the parish web site or at the office of the Clerk. Most significantly 20 trees along Browns Lane are now protected.
