PREVIOUS MINUTES

58/22 The Council unanimously resolved to adopt the draft minutes from the Parish Council Meeting held on 16th May 2022 with no amendments made

GROUNDS MAINTENANCE CONTRACT

59/22 The Council discussed the existing grounds maintenance contract. It was suggested that the visibility around the village entrance signs needs to be improved as well as parts of the hedgerow on the A447.

60/22 The Council resolved to defer extending the contract to include the maintenance of verges around gateways until any extra costs can be determined.

61/22 The Council noted the letter to be sent to owners of overgrown hedge on Barton Road, Osbaston that is blocking footpath

PARISH COUNCILLOR VACANCY

62/22 No applications were received for the position of Parish Councillor. This decision will be deferred until the vacancy is re-considered in September

JUBILEE EVENTS

- 63/22 The Council noted that the delivery of the Jubilee mugs to every Parishioner was very well received with most circulated. There was also positive feedback regarding the Jubilee Bench. The Council will sell any remaining mugs for £5 subject to availability.
- 64/22 The Council unanimously agreed to donate the removed bench from Barton Road to Nailstone church following the installation of the Jubilee bench

FINANCE

- 65/22 The Council unanimously agreed to adopt the financial statement for May - June 2022
- 66/22 The Council noted payments requiring Council authorisation of £3737.67
- 67/22 The Council noted the bank balance for June 2022 of £7299.10

PLANNING

- 68/22 **22/00568/HOU** – Proposed solar panel shed - Ash Barn Fields Farm Goatham Lane Osbaston Nuneaton Leicestershire – No Comment
- 69/22 The Council agreed to write a formal complaint to LCC Highways due to speeding, increased traffic, HGV's using the road with 67.5 tonne limit eroding the verge. The Clerk to also write a formal complaint to school bus service who use the route for Bosworth High School.
- 70/22 The Council noted an update on Piggerys Café. Borough Councillor Bill Crooks informed the Chair that that there was nothing more than can be done until it is clear that the Café is operational. The Clerk to contact Planning Enforcement and advise Council on any further actions.
