(REVOCATION, 30MPH AND 40MPH SPEED LIMIT)
ORDER 2023

NOTICE is hereby given that Somerset Council proposes to make the above Order in pursuance of the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which is to introduce a 30mph and 40mph Speed Limit on the lengths of road as specified in Schedules 1 and 2 to this Order.

The County Council of Somerset (Various Roads, Wheddon Cross, Exford, Bridgetown and Simonsbath) (20mph, 30mph and 40mph Speed Limits) Order 2002 is part revoked as per Schedule 3 to this Order. The provisions of any other Orders are hereby revoked but only in so far as they are affected by the restrictions imposed by this Order.

A copy of the draft Order, the maps showing the length of road affected and the Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at Somerset County Council, A Block Reception, County Hall, Taunton and online at www.somerset.gov.uk/TRO.

B3358 Simonsbath to Challacombe Road, Minehead	From the junction with the B3223 Exford to Simonsbath Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 700 metres
Simonsbath to Challacombe Road Access, Minehead	For its entire length
Field Studies Centre Lane, Minehead	For its entire length
Simonsbath House Lane, Minehead	For its entire length
