Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 Request for Information

Thank you for your request for information, received on 2 July 2015. Your request has been dealt with in accordance with the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002.

I note that you have requested a breakdown of the number of pupils from the Stonehouse area who would be affected by the proposals for secondary school transport. In response to your request, I can advise you that based on current secondary school transport applications, 21 pupils from the Stonehouse area would be affected by the proposals.

Request for Review

The Council has an internal panel (the review panel) to deal with complaints from people who are not happy about the way that their request has been dealt with. Staff not involved in the original decision will handle any review. If you want to complain about how we have handled your request for information, you can ask the review panel to reassess our actions. Please note that if you wish to complain, you must do so by 25 September 2015. Please note that the review panel can only assess the way we have handled requests for information. It cannot consider complaints about delivery of a service or any decisions made by the Council or its authorised employees. If your complaint relates to one of these matters, you should contact the Resource responsible.

Should you not be satisfied with the outcome of our review, you will then have the right to appeal to the Scottish Information Commissioner. The Commissioner will decide whether your request has been dealt with properly, in accordance with the Act.
