Councillor Dornan,

Below is an outline of the approach we use consistently to project school rolls from new house building.

The educational accommodation requirements for primary accommodation are calculated on the following basis:

- 30 pupils per year group per 1000 housing units.
- A pupil split of 75% non-denominational and 25% denominational.
- Based on 7 year groups.

This formula would therefore generate 1 primary aged child per 5 houses with a split between the non-denominational and denominational sector 75% to 25%.

In reality, many houses may provide more school aged children than this formula but likewise, many houses will provide less or indeed no school aged children. However as a planning tool, this is as close a prediction as possible and indeed is very similar to other local authorities, although the denominational / non-denominational split may vary.

We have recently tested our predictions over a 3 year period and in the Primary sector we are within 1% of our predicted numbers and within 0.01% of our predictions in the secondary sector.

As catchment areas are historic we have a number of schools that are closer to housing developments that are not the catchment's school and this is the case for this development. We have no current plans to alter the catchment area which would have to go through the process of a statutory consultation
