	<p>George Smith provided an brief overview of the meeting he had with Joanne Forbes and outlined the direction that he felt SLC were pushing them. George outlined that the direction was towards a community trust and Joanne advised that A community trust existed in East Kilbride and operated along site a development trust.</p> <p>Liz and Bill intimated that Stonehouse Development Trust was a community trust limited by Guarantee and that whilst they had not heard of community trust the Articles and Association would be the same as the Development Trust.</p> <p>Some discussion took place over this matter and, with George advising that this was the direction that SLC were pushing and that a community trust with all organisations owning a stake in the hall would work together for it. Bill stated that if need be the Articles and association of the Development trust could be changed at an EGM to reflect a different management make up and if need be the name could be changed to a community trust.</p> <p>George thought the community trust was a good idea as if all organisations had a stake then they were more likely to offer and carry out work on the hall. George stated it was his opinion that the development trust had difficulty getting the public buy into the development trust.
