Chair indicated that this was likely to be on greenbelt and that an indoor riding area was already on the site. Secretary to examine previous application to establish what had been approved and to circulate location plan.</p> <p><u>Site adjacent to persimmons hospitals site</u> Secretary had received an email regards ground investigation works in the railway cutting next to the hospital site. Agreed that chair will contact councillor Campbell and secretary will write back to Mr dick who contacted the CC to ask if he had any pictures of the work being carried out.</p> <p><u>Village Plan</u> Chair to contact peter Ramsay for an update.</p> <p><u>Covid Grant</u> Chair advised that the foodbank was looking for presents for kids Christmas presents.
