Taking care of your sewer network in Stonehouse

What we are doing

Further to our letter issued 22nd June providing early notification about a section of Townhead Road to be closed, we now write to remind you of the road closure dates and provide further details about the buses.

When are we doing it

A section of Townhead Street from the entrance of the primary school to Vicars Road is be closed to vehicular traffic from 29th August for 3 months. Please see map on page 2 for details.

Your water supply and drainage services from your kitchen and bathroom should not be affected by our work.

What happens next

- The project is to help prevent sewer flooding. The work involves excavating the road and installing new larger sewer pipes, with new manholes on a section of Townhead Street and Vicars Road.
- A vehicular diversion route will in place via the Stonehouse bypass during the works. Please leave additional time for your journey. Footpaths by the work area will remain open as normal.
- Bus services and school transport will be affected by the road closure. Please see the attached sheet providing further details. Please note that the buses will turnaround using Queen Street. There will be parking restrictions along sections of Queen Street. Please ensure you adhere to the parking restrictions in place as failure to do so will result in delays or cancellation of services if buses get stuck.
- We have finished laying the section of sewer pipe work in the school car park and will reinstate the school grounds back to normal.

Thank you for your patience and understanding while we complete this essential work.

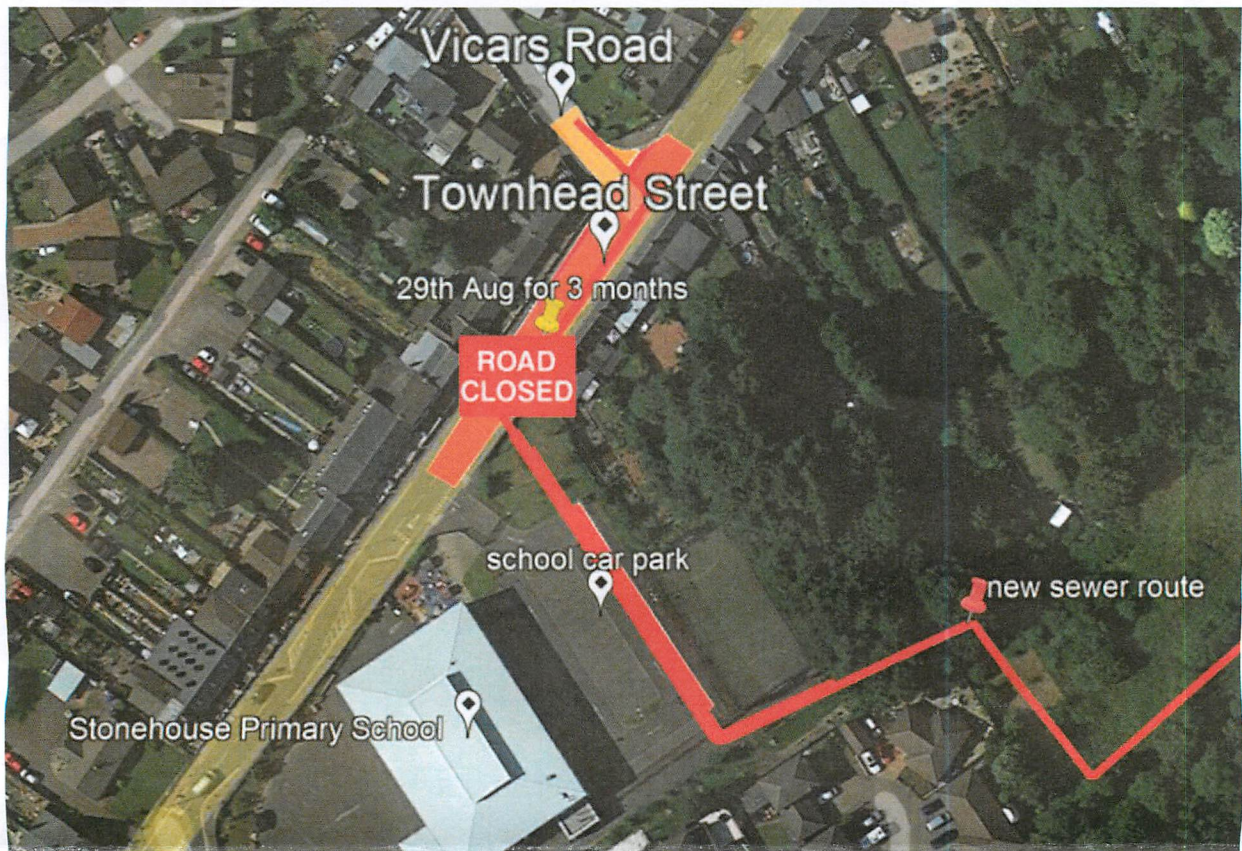
