Summary of Community Council Zoom meeting during Covid 19

It was approved at the meeting that we would buy more tablets to distribute between the 3 local schools, the cost of the tablets is about £1500 and we would procure funding for the tablets from Banks Renewables.

We have also obtained 250 visors from Glasgow University free of charge, which we will distribute between local business's, Shona had contacted Tesco as we had hoped to use their car park as a meeting place, Tesco have not agreed to this so we will need to decide on an alternate meeting place.

Shona has also made up crafts packs for young children to complete. We will advertise on facebook and speak to the schools about how to distribute packs.

We have also agreed to purchase the following if we get funding approved from Banks Renewables:

1. 100 bottles and 20 Jerry Cans Hand Sanitiser
2. Craft packs for pre school kids and kids aged 5-10, fitbits and journals for teens and puzzle packs for adults.
3. Tablets for children to use to help with their home learning

The cost of this is looking between £3500 and £4000, Jim will complete form over the next few days and sent it to Banks Renewables.
