#### 2. <u>Previous minutes</u>

The previous minutes were taken as read and they were adopted by Margaret and seconded by Catriona.

## 3. Hollandbush Golf Club

Maragaret advised Lesmahagow CC should support the golf club in its bid to stay open and avoid closure, Ross Gowland advised has a meeting with the council to discuss this further, It was suggested they could look at potential REF funding or potentially go down the asset transfer route.

## 4. Persimmon Homes

Margaret advised had emailed and has had no response. Gordon advised we need to know how much money and where the money is going to that will be given to Lesmahagow under section 75.

## 5. McKirdy Park

Ailsa advised McKirdy park was awarded £25000.00 from the KMCP fund. Ailsa will contact the developer Liz to get an updated cost, currently looking at roughly £185000.00

# 6. <u>KMCP</u>

Ailsa advised that £52000.00 has been given to Lesmahagow, this includes £25000 for the park The rest was split between Milton Primary, Woodpark Primary and the Highland Games.

# 7. <u>DVAG</u>

Mark went to the last meeting and advised not much to report apart from they will have an AGM shortly.

## 8. Cumberhead

Gordon advised they are now open again for applications and the closing date is 29/02/2024. Angus who has previously ran the group is moving on, Gordon will find out what is going to happen once he leaves.

## 9. Microgrant

#### 11. Finance Report
