The massed ringing sessions will all be conducted by Susie Dingle. Susie is an orchestral and choral conductor who trained at the State Conservatory of St Petersburg and the Royal Scottish Academy of Music and Drama. Recent projects have included conducting a 120-strong orchestra of young musicians in East Lothian for NYOS Engage for a concert at St Mary's, Haddington in May. Some of you may have met her at the HRGB National Rally last year in Stirling, where she enjoyed conducting the Far North Ringers.

For the massed ringing sessions at this rally, we are offering three new pieces, written and arranged by Katrina Gordon (musical director of the Caithness Handbell Ringers). These pieces will form part of the informal performance which will be open to the public at 4pm on Saturday.

Reflective Contemplations by Katrina Gordon


