COACH RAMBLER TO APPLEBY 9TH MAY 2010

This excursion is a return visit to the delightful village of Appleby where hopefully it will be Bluebell time. The rendezvous will be at Burton services M6. Bookings will be taken for Hathersage in the Peak District on June 6th (book early please as I am away again soon), Helmsley on the edge of the North York Moors on July 4th and Llangollen on 1st August. COACHES RETURN FROM APPLEBY OUTSIDE TIC AT 6 PM

'A' PARTY 14 ½ MILES MOD/STRENUOUS LEADER HARVEY THOMPSON
Alight at Appleby and walk through Flakebridge, Harbour Flatt and onto open access land. Follow High Cup Gill Beck to the top of High Cup Nick and continue over the moor to Murton Fell and onto Murton Pike. Descend to Murton Village and back into Appleby.

'B' PARTY 10 MILES MODERATE LEADER CHRIS THORNLEY
Alight Appleby and pass the railway station to Stank Lane and Stank Woods. Field paths and tracks Shepherds Cottage and then continue to Murton village. Ascend Murton Pike for lovely views across the Eden valley then drop down by way of a track to Murton Village. Continue on quiet lanes and field paths to Swindale Brow. Then follow a bridleway to Hilton village, Brackenber, Brackenber Moor, Langton and back into Appleby.

'C' PARTY 8 MILES MODERATE LEADER MICHAEL COUNTER
Alight Appleby and follow the Lady Anne Way along the riverside to Great Ormside, Leazes Hill, Looking Flat, Hoff, Cudding Hole, Brandey Bridge, Parkinhill and Appleby.

'D' PARTY 6 ½ MILES FAIRLY EASY LEADER PAUL BROWN
Alight in Appleby, and follow field paths and good tracks past Dowpits Wood to Limekiln Hill and the small village of Colby where we have lunch. On leaving Colby we join an undulating country lane for about ½ mile, and then follow tracks and paths to Jerusalem Farm and Bandley Bridge, before returning to Appleby along Colby Lane. Some mud in places but pleasant countryside with views of the North Pennines throughout.
