COACHES RETURN FROM CONISTON AT 5.30 PM

'A' PARTY 10 MILES STRENUOUS LEADER CHRIS THORNLEY Alight at Torver and follow bridleway to Scarr Head then continue to Walna Scar Road, then west to Brown Pike and ascend Buck Pike, Dow Crag, Goats Hause and up to Coniston Old Man. Descend to Low Water, Crowberry Haws and Miners Bridge, and then walk back into Coniston. Route may change subject to weather.

'B' PARTY 9 ½ MILES MODERATE LEADER FRANK WALKER
Alight at Lowick Bridge GR and follow field paths to Subberthwaite Bank and the Cumbria Way to Beacon
Tarn, Tottle Bank then Torver Common. Continue through Torver Wood and Lakeside back to Coniston.

'C' PARTY 8 MILES EASY LEADER SUE BAXENDALE Alight on A5084 after Water Yeat at GR 287905. Take Paths and a minor road to climb towards Stable Harvey farm. Follow the path along the wall to Coats Hill - (gentle climb with plenty of time), past Tyson Wood and down to cross the river at Sunny Bank. Continue along the road for short while then a bridleway to Mill Bridge and cross A593 to go into Torver then lanes to Low Torver Park. Re-cross Torver Beck to take field paths to Brackenbarrow Farm. Continue down through Torver Common Wood to lakeside. Follow path along lake side to camp site, then pass Coniston Hall and into Coniston village. Good tracks or minor roads all the way with one or two possible boggy bits to add to the fun.

'D'PARTY 7 MILES FAIRLY EASY LEADER ROGER HAYTHORNTHWAITE
Alight at first car park, at the southern end of Lake Coniston, opposite Park Nab GR 287905.
Take paths to near Stable Harvey and then Sunny Bank. After a short road walk follow the Cumbria Way to
Lake Coniston shore and follow, passing Bellman's Hole, Moor Gill Foot, Hoathwaite Landing and Coniston
Hall reaching Lake Road and the Lake then following permissive path to Coniston Village.
