## COACHES RETURN FROM HELMSLEY COACH PARK AT 6 PM

'A' PARTY 13 ½ MILES MODERATE LEADER FRANK WALKER Alight at the top of Sutton Bank and follow the Cleveland Way north to High Paradise. Continue east to Dale town and then field paths down in to Rye Dale and on to Rievaulx. Then follow the Cleveland Way again eastwards to Helmsley.

'B' PARTY 11 MILES MODERATE LEADER ROBERT ECCLES
Alight at the top of Sutton Bank and head south around the airfield to above the White Horse. After looping the
airfield join the Cleveland Way to Cold Kirby and drop down into Flassen Dale. Cross fields and woods to
Rievaulx. Continue south to rejoin the Cleveland Way at Rievaulx Bridge and continue in to Helmsley. Walk is
mainly on good tracks but there is some road walking. There is 350m of ascent and 550m of descent.

\*C\* PARTY 7 ½ MILES MODERATE LEADER ROBERT ECCLES
There is no leader for C party today. However C walkers can go with the B party and miss out a couple of
loops – you can have a rest or refreshments and wait for the B party to return to the beginning of the loop
before continuing on your way. For route follow information as given in B or take it easy and join the D party.

'D' PARTY 6 ½ MILES EASY LEADER BRIAN CHADDOCK Alight in Helmsley and walk on a track up Beck Dale to near High Baxtons Farm. Continue across field paths and return to Helmsley via Ash Dale. No stiles but two short inclines in first half of walk.
