COACHES RETURN FROM LLANGOLLEN COACH PARK AT 6 PM

'A' PARTY 11 MILES MODERATE LEADER ROBER ECCLES
Alight at the Ponderosa Cafe and walk over Cyrn-y-Brain to Worlds End. Follow the ridge to Craig y Adar and
Craig Arthur before crossing the moor to the highest point on Eglwyseg. Drop down to Trevor Rocks around
or through (time permitting) Casell Dinas Bray. A high level walk with great views, but some rough moorland.

B' PARTY 9 MILES MODERATE LEADER MICHAEL COUNTER Following Offa's dyke long distance footpaths alight at the Crown Inn Llandegla, field paths in to Llandegla forest climbing steadily to emerge on to open moorland. Country road down to Worlds End (no sign of Captain Jack Sparrow) and continue on footpaths aside the Eglwyseg Mountains. Leave Offa's Dyke footpath on to field paths to climb Casell Dinas Bran and descend to return to Llangollen. Spectacular views throughout.

'C' PARTY 8 MILES MODERATE LEADER CAROL AND DERRICK FIELDING Alight at the Ponderosa Cafe atop the Horseshoe Pass 1367' and descend by Clwydian Way and undulating path to Eglwyseg Glen. Continue on Offa's Dyke path to the foot of Trevor Rocks and make a STEEP ascent to a beautiful viewing terrace. Carry on along the terrace to make a gradual descent to the Panorama Way. Continue around the base of Casell Dinas Bran and back in to Llangollen.

'D' PARTY 7 MILES EASY LEADER ROGER HAYTHORNWAITE Alight in Llangollen; walk through the town, over the river Dee and uphill in a fairly steep climb to near Geufron then paths to Wern-Uchaf, Llandyn Hall Farm, Nyth-Y-Dryn, Bron Heulog and Ty-Canol. Turn south now towards the tow path of the Shropshire Union canal following it back in to Langollen (about 2.5 miles). A fine walk with lovely views of the Vale of Llangollen weather permitting
