COACH RAMBLER TO THE ROACHES STAFFORD 3RD OCTOBER 2010

COACHES RETURN FROM TITTESWORTH VISITOR COACH PARK AT 5.30PM PLEASE NOTE

'A' PARTY 12 MILES MODERATE LEADER ROBERT ECCLES
Alight at Landmanlow village and climb to trig point on Axe Edge Moor (551m). Continue South West over
Orchard and Knotbury Commons to Turn Edge and Luds Church. Climb on to the Roaches (550m) and follow
ridge to Hen Cloud before descending to Windy Gates. Walk to Meerbrook and on to the Visitor Centre.

'C' PARTY 8 ½ MILES MODERATE LEADER CAROL AND DERRICK FIELDING Alight at Tittesworth Reservoir and take paths to Upper Hulme. Walk around the base of Hen Cloud to Well Farm and then up on to the Roaches. Continue along the ridge to Bearstone Rock and Clough Head and then paths to Meerbrook and back to Tittesworth. Great long distance views subject to weather.

'D' PARTY 7 MILES FAIRLY EASY LEADER ROGER HAYTHORNTHWAITE Alight at Tittesworth Visitor Centre and start and continue round the Reservoir using the Staffordshire Moorland Walk with good views of the Roaches and the wild life of the Reservoir.
