COACHES RETURN FROM WINDERMERE (OUTSIDE TOURIST INFORMATION SHOP) AT 4.45 PM

Please note that there is limited coach parking in Windermere and the coaches will be parked at Bowness during the day and will return at 3.45pm. The TIC is a short distance down the hill from the Railway Station where the cafe and shop at Lakeland will be open until 5pm.

'A' PARTY 10 MILES MODERATE LEADER CHRIS THORNLEY
Alight at Staveley and follow the road to Scroggs Bridge. Continue along Brow Foot Lane to Browfoot, Croft Head, Kentmere Hall Plantation and Kentmere Hall. Continue on the Garburn Pass to Garburn Nook, Moor Head, Dubbs Road and Moor Howe. Field paths to near Orrest and Orrest Head then down into Windermere.

'B/C' PARTY 7 MILES MODERATE LEADER MICHAEL COUNTER
Alight at Staveley and follow the Dales Way towards New Hall. Road walking to Fell Plain then cross open country to Hag End. Follow a byway towards Windermere and field paths and a short hill climb to Orrest Head. Descend past Elleray Bank dropping down directly to Windermere.

'C/D' PARTY 6 ½ MILES MODERATE LEADER IAN THORNTON-BRYAR
Alight at Scream Point off A591 at Burnside and walk through the woods to Ratherheath Tarn and then a minor road and tracks to join the Dalesway at New Hall. Follow this undulating route to School Knott Tarn and climb to view point of School Knott then gently descend to Windermere Station.

'D' PARTY 5 MILES EASY LEADER PAT PARROTT
Alight at Ings and heading south an attractive walk onto the Dalesway via Borwick Fold and Outrun Nook, Hagg End and Heathwaite to Windermere. A short optional walk to Orrest head for great views.
