COACHES RETURN FROM ARNSIDE AT 6PM VIA THE M6

Note during the day the coaches will park at a suitable point by the roadside in or outside the village

'A' PARTY 13 MILES STRENUOUS LEADER CHRIS THORNLEY
Alight at Kirkby Lonsdale Devils Bridge and walk to Low Biggins, Hutton Roof, over Hutton Roof Crags, Clawthorpe Fell, Holme Park Quarry and Holme Park Farm. Then onto A6070 road, under the M6, over the Lancaster Canal to Holme. Over the west coast mainline railway via a footbridge, Hale Green, Hale Village and woodland paths to Slack Head, the Fairy Steps, Whin Scar and Hazelslack Tower. Return to Arnside via the Coffin Route and Arnside Moss.

'B' PARTY 9 MILES MODERATE LEADER PAUL BROWN
Alight at Milnthorpe, and walk alongside the river Bela before crossing it, walking through the Dallam Tower Deer Park to Haverbrack. Continue on field and woodland paths to Hazelslack, then along tracks and field paths to Leighton Beck Bridge. Walk through the Gait Barrows Nature Reserve past Hawes Water, and then continue again on field paths and along a quiet lane to join the Limestone Link. Follow this over Arnside Moss, then cross the railway and walk into Arnside Village. There are plenty of things of interest on this walk.

'C' PARTY 8 ½ MILES MODERATE LEADER MICHAEL COUNTER
Alight Moss Side lay-by on A65 (just before M6 J36) and follow the Westmoreland Way, along the Lancaster Canal to Holme, Limestone Link Footpath to Pye Bridge, Hale, Slack Head, Longtail Wood, Sandside and Coastal Footpath to Arnside.

'D' PARTY 7 MILES FAIRLY EASY LEADERS JOHN AND MARGARET ALLEN
Alight at Sandside and walk to Hazelslack, Arnside Tower, around Arnside Knott and back into Arnside.
