COACHES RETURN FROM CASTLETON AT 6PM

'A' PARTY 13 MILES STRENUOUS LEADER HARVEY THOMPSON
Alight at Snake Pass (Doctors Gate Culvert). Follow the Pennine Way over Featherbed Moss to Kinder Downfall then Kinder Low (633m) our highest point of the day. Return to the Pennine bridleway and walk on a long ridge leading to Lords Seat, Mam Tor and Hollins Cross. Descend quickly in to Castleton. Good paths.

'B' PARTY 9 MILES MOD/ STRENUOUS LEADER ROBERT ECCLES
Alight at Ladybower Reservoir and climb out of the valley to Wind Hill (476m). Continue west to Townhead and then to Lose Hill (476m). Follow the ridge to Hollins Cross and Mam Tor (552m) before dropping down to the 'melting road' and across the fields to Castleton. Two 300m climbs rewarded by panoramic views.

'C' PARTY 8 MILES MODERATE LEADER CAROL & DERRICK FIELDING
Alight in Hope then a gradual ascent past Losehill Farm, through Brocket booth Plantation to barker Bank. Follow ridge past Hollins Cross onto Mam Tor. Descend past Windy Knoll to join Limestone Way making a gradual rocky descent through beautiful Cave Dale back to Castleton.

'D' PARTY 7 MILES MODERATE LEADER SUE BAXENDALE
Alight on A6013 adjacent to picnic site Ladybower Reservoir. Follow the Derwent Valley Trail along the disused railway line and field paths to the village of Shatton. Continue along Townfield Lane to Brough and then more field paths to Hope. Path over railway line, through fields and past Spring House Farm to Castleton
