COACHES RETURN FROM GLENRIDDING AT 6PM

'A' PARTY 13 MILES STRENUOUS LEADER ROBERT ECCLES
Alight at Pooley Bridge and climb onto Askham Fell to follow the High Street to Loadpot Hill (672m). Descend to Christy Bridge (188m) and climb again to Heart Cragg and Place Fell (657). Drop down into Patterdale and return to Glenridding via Lanty's Tarn or the roadway subject to the time available. Lots of ups and downs.

'B' PARTY 10 MILES MODERATE LEADER CHRIS THORNLEY
Alight Glenridding and walk to Patterdale, then Side Farm and continue to Boredale House. Climb Place Fell then descend to Sandwick. Continue on a bridleway along the shore of Ullswater back to Side Farm. Then re-trace our steps to return to Glenridding.

C/D PARTY 7 ½ MILES FAIRLY EASY LEADER PAUL BROWN
Alight near Hartsop, walk through the hamlet then continue to Sykeside and Hartsop Hall, then alongside Brotherswater to Cow Bridge. Continue on a good track to Dubhow, Rooking, and Side Farm, cross Goldrill Beck (bridge) to reach Patterdale Village. From here take pleasant paths into Glenridding. Plenty of things to see on this walk. **Please note - if you are joining this walk please stay on the coach when it reaches Glenridding.**

'D' PARTY 6 MILES FAIRLY EASY LEADER CAROL FIELDING
A walk and a sail today. Alight just after leaving motorway at the junction of Dacre Road on A592. Take field paths alongside the River Earmont to Pooley Bridge, lakeside to Waterside House, and more field paths via Cross Dormont and Thwaite Hill, then a gradual ascent to Auterstone to join the bridleway to Howtown. The 40 minute sail from Howtown to Glenridding costs £5.80 but a 10% discount is available for a group of 12. A sub will be available to those who have not brought enough cash but still want to do the walk.
