### COACHES RETURN FROM RICHMOND COACH PARK AT 6PM

**'A' PARTY** 14 MILES MOD/ STRENUOUS LEADER ROBERT ECCLES  
Alight at Downholme Bridge and follow the river to Marrick before climbing to Skelton Moor. Continue to Orgate Force and under limestone cliffs to Marske. Finally follow fields by Applegarth Scar and then the River Swale back in to Richmond.

**'B' PARTY** There is no B party today

**'C' PARTY** 8 MILES MODERATE LEADER BRIAN CHADDOCK  
Alight in Richmond and walk to High Leases and over fields to Willances Leap. Continue to the top of Deep Dale and then join the road down Clapgate Bank onto a track below Applegarth Scar and onto Low Applegarth. Returning to Richmond via the footpath alongside the River Swale and crossing Richmond Bridge

**'D' PARTY** 6 MILES MODERATE LEADER PAUL BROWN  
Alight in Richmond and walk through the market square, then downhill to Richmond Bridge to cross the River Swale. Follow an undulating path through Billy Bank Wood, and then descend to cross the river again by footbridge at Round Howe for lunch. Continue on field and woodland paths climbing gradually to Low Applegarth to join the Coast to Coast route back to Richmond. Expect some good views across the Swale ravine and of Richmond Castle.
