Grassington 08 January 2012

In December we were south of the Craven fault but today we're more or less on top of it to give us the limestone of the Yorkshire Dales and the millstone grit of the South Pennines in a single trip.

Again we have just the one main coach; but this was anticipated due to the time of year and relatively local destination. Since we're not losing money, we're out walking and we're catching up after the festivities I can't see a down-side to this extra trip (although the weather may have other ideas).

The Blackburn feeder coach and Burnley main coach will combine around Gisburn and then head straight for Grassington. We're not having an official toilet stop but if the Blackburn feeder manages to wangle one at Gisburn then please be quick about it!

Today's Walks

A Walk **Robert Eccles**

Starting from just after the Craven Heifer we trundle over Flasby Fell and down into Rylstone. From there we visit the cross and the obelisk before crossing the Fell and dropping into Thorpe. Our journey from Thorpe to Grassington will depend on the weather: if it's fine we'll go via Burnsall and Hebden for a 16 mile walk but if it's not good we'll take a short-cut on the Dales Way for a 14 mile walk. Walk classified as strenuous due to distance and time constraints rather than any ascent (plus there's a bit in the middle that may require a little wall hopping).

B Walk N/A

There is no official B walk today but if anybody feels like doing something between the A and C walks then have a word with me (Robert Eccles). I can't guarantee to sort something (see above!) but I'll do my best.

C Walk Paul Brown

This walks starts at Rylstone, from where we walk to Hetton, then join Moor Lane and walk northwestwards rising gradually for about one and a half miles, cross Boss Moor Lane, then continue round Hamerton Hill before descending to Eller Beck. We then walk north eastwards to the lovely village of Linton. (Some interesting things to see here). We continue on lanes and field paths to Linton Falls, cross the River Wharfe by footbridge and walk up Sedber Lane to the coaches. Most of this walk follows good tracks but please be ready for some muddy stretches.

D Walk Frank Mason

Alight at Grassington Car Park, Tourist Information Centre. Footpath to Linton Falls and Church, field paths and minor road to Thorpe and then to Burnsall. Back to Grassington following the Dales Way and River Wharfe.

Money, Money, Money

The Area Coach isn't about making money. Granted we need to balance the books, secure our future and make sure we pay our way but, minor details, that's all. Thus I intend to limit our reserve to about £1,500. This is just about enough to cover the future commitments.

Once we have that buffer then any excess from a trip will be refunded to passengers and late cancellations as a credit against another trip. However, if we drop below the £1,500 mark, then £50 will be added to the coffers before any refunds are made.

In practical terms this could mean a refund of around £2:00 per trip for regular passengers (ca 15% - 20%). Not a fantastic amount but that's just because the standard ticket price is already very close to that needed to safely cover costs.
