Dent via Sedbergh 13 May 2012

Today we have two coaches for our trip to the edge of the Yorkshire Dales. We'll have a brief stop at Settle before heading to where Cumbria, Lancashire and North Yorkshire meet.



Dent is small but has realised that its future is with visitors. The Heritage Centre (£2.75-£3.75, closes at 4pm) has an exhibition of local life and culture in previous centuries. The cobbled streets, church and art galleries are worthy of inspection; as are the two cafes and three pubs.

The Meadowside Cafe (just on the right from the coach park) has kindly offered to extend their opening hours until 6pm for us. It's a refreshing change to find a cafe that knows customers are good despite the time they turn up!

Today's Walks

A Walk Harvey Thompson

14.5 miles Moderate

THE TWO HIGHEST MOUNTAINS IN LANCASHIRE.

Marching out from Ingleton (which is in North Yorkshire but has a Lancashire postal address) we head for Ireby. Two short country lane sections lead us to the off piste climb fort Gragareth (2057') the County's second highest point. Following the boundary with Yorkshire we soon summit Green Hill at 2060' the highest point in Lancashire. A short descent and we are soon into Cumbria. With a short climb we soon reach Great Coum (2254') our highest point of the day. Next we have a steep down hill, a trip along an ancient bridleway and soon we are in Dent. The walk is predominantly on well worn paths with 2756' of ascent.

B Walk Chris Thornley

9.5 miles Moderate

Starting from Dent we take a steep path up to Green Lane Track. Follow it to the head of Deepdale. Then we follow field paths down Deepdale and join The Dales Way. We follow The Dales Way for about a mile. Then we take a path to the north side of Dentdale. Then we take field paths and tracks along the north side of the valley back into Dent village. A lovely circular tour of beautiful Dentdale.

C Walk Michael Counter

8 miles Moderate

Alight the coach in Dent, field paths to High Ground passing waterfalls, Green Lane, down Nun House Outrake into Deepdale, Wallers Bridge, Dyke House Lane, Manor Farm, Tonny Bridge, Basil Busk, follow field paths down Dentdale, Backstone Gill, Hall Bank, Church Bridge and into Dent Village. This route offers some spectacular views of the waterfalls behind Dent and Yorkshire Dale scenery at its very best. The initial climb out of Dent is tough, but well worth the energy spent.

D Walk Pat Parrott

6 miles Easy

A classic Dentdale walk. Alight Sedbergh. Walk down to and through Millthrop, and follow the Dales Way to Dent, via the Golf Course, Gap, down by Gate Manor and across Brackensgill Bridge, Continue on the south side of the river into Dent. There will be plenty of time to explore Dent, visit cafe or pub, look at the church or just wander.

06:15 PM Sedbergh Library Bus Stop (opposite Post Office)
