Today's Walks

A Walk Harvey Thompson

10 miles Moderate

HARDEN BRIDGE TO INGLETON

Hear about the witches of Austwick. See the huge boulders of the Norber Erratics. Question as to how Nature created Trow Gill. Ponder and think about St. Paul's Cathedral fitting into Gaping Ghyll? Visit Little Ingleborough before climbing to the top of what was once though to be the highest mountain in the Country.

Did people actually life on top of Ingleborough? Saunter down to find Beezley and Snow Falls. Find out about the quarries, coal mines, the central court and tourism, which were so important in the development of Ingleton. This is a very rewarding day out!

The walk is a moderate A Walk on well established paths 10 miles long with 3478 feet of ascent.

B Walk Frank Walker

9.5 miles Moderate

We leave the coach at the top of Buck Haw Brow then follow Brunton Road and track to Austwick followed by short field path and Thwaite Lane to Clapham. Further field paths to Newby, Goat Gap, Cold Cotes, More Garth Hall and then into Ingleton.

C Walk Paul Brown

7 miles Fairly Easy

This walk starts at Harden Bridge on the A65, and takes us through the villages of Austwick, Clapham, Newby, and Cold Cotes. We walk first into Austwick, then join Thwaite Lane which we follow to Clapham, then continue along Laithbutts Lane to Newby, then follow tracks and field paths to Cold Cotes. From here we walk along Lowkber Lane and Green Lane, then join Old Road which takes us into Ingleton. A bit of local history along the way, with the chance of some good views of the limestone scenery.

D Walk Roger Haythornwaite

5 miles Fairly Easy

Alight at Ingleton. Walk through village to the entrance of the Waterfalls Trail. Walk the whole way round the Trail in a clockwise direction. The walk takes in the beautiful Pecca, Beezly and Snow waterfalls together with the iconic Thornton Force. The route is undulating and in places quite steep both up and down. A good walk whatever the weather! N.B., this walk will require an additional £5 for entry to The Waterfalls.
