Keswick / Seatoller 12 May 2013

Today we have two coaches for our trip to the Northern Lakes. The Burnley and Blackburn coaches will rendezvous at Burton in Kendal services and travel together to Keswick and then on to Seatoller.



With the C walk having a ferry to catch and the D walk travelling into Borrowdale, it would be appreciated if we could make the rendezvous stop at Burton as short as possible.

If any independent walker needs a lift back from Seatoller (or Rosthwaite) to Keswick then please check the times and options with me.

Today's Walks

A Walk Chris Thornley

11 miles Strenuous

Alight at Keswick and follow the Cumbria Way to Portinscale. Then pick up the Allerdale Ramble and follow it south to Silver Hill and Derwent Bay. Then climb Cat Bells. Continue to Maiden Moor and High Spy. Then gird your loins for a big drop down to Dalehead Tarn and a big climb up to Dale Head summit. From here there are great veiws down the Newlands Valley and the surrounding fells if it's clear. Then from the summit cairn we take a path south down to Honister Hause. Then we follow a bridle way down the Honister Pass to Seatoller. Please note there are some steep climbs on this walk.

Return to Keswick via one of the coaches as soon as the walk finishes.

B Walk Frank Walker

11 miles Moderate

Starting from Threlkeld we head west to pick up the disused railway along the Greta. Turning south we make a bee-line for Low Rigg, closely followed by High Rigg before dropping down to Bridge End Farm. From here we start out journey back to Keswick via woods and farm land.

If the weather is bad then we'll miss out Low / High Rigg to walk down the lovely St John's in the Vale and we may also be able to include the Castlerigg stone circle; we'll see on the day.

C Walk Michael Counter

7 miles Moderate

Alight the coach in Keswick and then we make our way down to the lake ferry. (The ferry cost is covered by your coach ticket.) We alight the ferry at the first stop at Ashness Gate and then proceed to slowly climb the lane that lead to Ashness Bridge, for that chocolate box photograph. The route continues through Ladore Wood and the Watendlath valley to arrive at the hamlet of Watendlath. The walk now begins to rise over Puddinstone Bank 1000 ft and the Resting Stone before dropping into the village of Rosthwaite. The Cumbria Way is now followed leading directly into Seatoller. Some hills are encountered but nothing too strenuous.

Return to Keswick via one of the coaches as soon as the walk finishes.

D Walk Roger Haythornthwaite

6 miles Fairly Easy

Alight at Lodore Falls Hotel and take paths along southern and western shores of Derwent Water to Hawes End Outdoor Centre. Leaving the shore, walk through the pleasant Overside Wood and Fawe Park to the Nichol End Boatyard. Refreshments, if required at this stage, may be available at the nearby Dandelion Cafe operated by HF at Derwentbank. Afterwards walk through Portinscale, cross the suspension bridge and proceed to Keswick.

The coaches will be parked at Seatoller for most of the day and return to Keswick from 4PM onwards depending on when the A and C walks finish.
