Hutton le Hole 04 August 2013

Today we have two coaches for our trip to this very popular Ryedale village. The Burnley and Blackburn coaches will rendezvous at Ripon and then travel to Hutton le Hole via Sutton Bank and Helmsley.



It's just nine years since we last visited the place. Many though will remember our last attempt to get there in 2007 when one coach threw its toys out of the cot at the sight of Sutton Bank.

Today's Walks

A Walk Harvey Thompson

14 miles Moderate

We start from the village of Sutton-under-Whitestonecliff and walk up the Cliff to Sutton Bank. Passing the site of the Battle of Byland we see the famous White Horse of Kilburn. We may find out if glider spotting is still popular here! A quick about turn and onto the village of Hambleton, where there are two racehorse-training stables. We cross over the River Rye and follow the canal to Rievaulx Abbey. Leaving the Abbey we stroll into Helmsley, our final destination and our pick-up point.

A moderate walk with 1375 ft of ascent.

B Walk Robert Eccles

10½ miles Moderate

Starting at Nawton we walk along Guncroft Lane to Skiplam Grange and Blue Scar Wood. Then it's through the woods in Kirk Dale to Cherry Tree Farm and Penny Holme. Turning north east over farmland we eventually reach the Access Land and cross Harland Moor and drop down into "Dove Dale".

We more or less follow the river through the woods to Lowna Bridge before turning sort of east and making for Hutton le Hole alongside The Nab.

This is a moderate walk, based on Alan Livesey's 2007 plan, with 423m of ascent.

C Walk Michael Counter

8 miles Moderate

Alight the coach at Kirkbymoorside and follow field paths we arrive at Kirkdale cave. We now turn to head north, passing St Georges Minsterand then entering Kirkdale and onto the forest and river side tracks until Dripping Well. We now leave the valley and head up towards the villages of Fadmoor and Gillamoor.

We pass the "Suprise View" presenting a spectacular view of Lower Farndale. The route now continues on past Shepards Nab and on into Hutton le Hole.

D Walk Paul Brown

61/2 miles Moderate

We leave the coaches at a parking area on the A170 about a mile east of Nawton (Grid Ref-SE 676 848). We follow field paths and country lanes to Kirkdale, calling to look at St Gregory's Minster (Saxon church), then cross Hodge Beck (footbridge & ford) then walk on field paths to the small market town of Kirkbymoorside. We continue in a northwards direction to High Park Farm and Cockpit Hall to reach the pleasant village of Gillamoor.

We then descend to cross the River Dove, before climbing gradually along moor and field paths to arrive at Hutton le Hole for well earned refreshments.

Today we have two pick-up points.

06:15 PM Helmsley Bus stop on A170 (main road) near The Feathers Walks: A

Independent walkers: if you're getting on at Helmsley please inform your courier so we know not to wait for you at Hutton le Hole.

Blackburn coach is down to drop off at Clitheroe first and the Burnley coach at Barrowford / Colne. Any additional stops are at the discretion of our drivers and couriers but need to take into account everyone's desire to get home quickly.
