Today's Walks

A Walk **Robert Eccles** 14½ miles Moderate

Starting from Newby Bridge we head through Great Wood to Bishop's Allotment and Backbarrow. Across the River Leven, under the railway and then through the woods to Lane End. At Pool Foot we turn south to pick up the Cumbria Coastal Way to Greenodd where we turn north west across fields to Stainton Gap and Lowick Common. Then we've across fields before climbing to Hoad Hill and the monument for, hopefully, fantastic views. A quick zigzag down the hill and we've in Ulverston.

14-15 miles of relatively easy walking with 2,500 feet of ascent.

B Walk **Chris Thornley**

9 miles Moderate

Alight at the Anglers Arms in Haverthwaite, then a short road/footpath walk to cross the River Leven where we join the Cumbria Coastal Way. We follow this for about 2 miles, crossing the Leven estuary by a long footbridge, and then walking on to Greenodd village. From Greenodd we walk to Penny Bridge, then follow undulating field paths and quiet lanes to Low Scathwaite, Bencragg Hill, and Bowstead Gates. We continue to the Falls, then climb fairly steeply for about a mile to reach the tower on Hoad Hill. Panoramic views from here. We then descend steeply, before walking into Ulverston.

C Walk Michael Counter

8 miles Moderate

Alight just after Booths and walk along Britain's smallest canal for views over Morecambe Way. We enjoy the Cumbrian Coastal Way to make our way to the pebble beach for lunch; we continue along the beach for 1 mile to Bardsea then climb up thro' the village to Willington Wood and Red Lane. Then we continue using paths, tracks, and roads to Swarthmoor Hall, an important site of the Quakers, and on into Ulverston.

If time permits, we can pay a quick visit to the memorial to take in the views.

D Walk

6 miles Moderate

We alight in Ulverston, walk through the town centre to join the Cumbria Way for a short distance only, then follow field paths to Rosside Farm. We climb steadily to Fell Side Farm and then join a track to the highest point of the walk at Copse Hill (good views from here). We descend to Pennington Reservoir and then follow country lanes to Pennington and Loppergarth. From here we follow field paths and lanes to Swarthmoor Hall, before walking back into Ulverston for refreshments.
