Today's Walks

A Walk Robert Eccles Off first on A574 14 miles Moderate

Starting at Sampool Bridge we head up Whitbarrow and walk along the Scar before dropping down to Witherslack Hall. Continuing west we cross the River Winster and climb Hare Hill and drop down to High Newton. Now it's essentially south via fields, tracks and minor roads to Cartmel. A final turn east takes us to the top of Hampsfell and the Hospice before dropping down via Eggerslack Wood to Grange. Weather permitting, expect good vies of the southern fells and Morecambe Bay.

To join this walk you need to board the Blackburn coach at the services.

B Walk George McAvoy and Pauline O'Donall

Off third at Grange

10 miles Moderate

Starting from Grange we climb through Eggerslack Wood to Hampsfell and the Hospice. Turning north we go through the allotments before dropping down to Broughton Lodge Farm. There is a little now on quiet minor roads to Broughton Hall. A mixture of field paths and tracks gets us to Beckside, Wall Nook and finally Cartmel. Depending on conditions, the route to Grange will either be a meander or a bee-line!

A varied walk with about 1,500' of ascent.

C Walk Gillian Whittaker

Off second at Lindale

8 miles Moderate

Starting from the village of Lindale we pick up a bridleway heading north west to Hollow Lane. Then we're west to Broughton Lodge Farm, Hampsfell Hall, Old House Wood, Green Bank and Beckside. Turning south we reach and cross. Neatly dodging the hurdles, the racecourse at Cartmel. Now it's east on the Cistercian Way to the Hospice on Hampsfell before dropping down through Eggerslack Wood to Grange.

Expect a varied walk with, weather permitting, great views.

To join this walk you need to board the Burnley coach at the services.

D Walk Paul Brown

Off third at Grange

61/2 miles Moderate

We start this walk in Grange over Sands and walk steadily uphill (fairly steeply) for about ¾ mile to reach High Farm. We continue to Spring Bank, then on into the village of Allithwaite to join the Cumbria Coastal Way. We walk to Kents Bank, go past Guides Farm, then further on join the promenade for a pleasant and interesting walk alongside the bay to take us back into the town.

Most of this walk is on good surfaces and there should be some distant views to enjoy across Morecambe Bay.
