Pooley Bridge 08 June 2014

Today we have two coaches for our trip to the north eastern lakes and the far end of Ullswater. The coaches will meet at Tebay Services on the M6 where we will re-arrange ourselves to travel to the start of our walks.



Special notes for today are:

- Our coaches will be parked in Glenridding for most of the day and only return to Pooley Bridge at about the pick-up time.
- The Blackburn and Burnley coaches are not travelling together after Shap so please get on the coach for your walk [indicated below in red] at Tebay Services.

Today's Walks

A Walk Harvey Thompson

Burnley Coach

15 miles Moderate

A clutch of Wainwright's (four in all), a view of one of Lakeland's most majestic Lakes and walking along a Roman Road. All this in a largely unfrequented valley. A walk not to be missed!

Starting in Shap Village we 'warm up' by visiting the hamlets of Rosgill, Brampton Grange and Brampton. Then a gradual climb to the summit of Wethergill and onto Load Pot Hill At 2201' our highest point of the day. Bonscale Pike and Arthur's Pike provide us with views to feast on! We stride to The Cockpit and wend our way down to Pooley Bridge.

The walk is 15 miles long on recognised paths with 2395' of ascent.

B Walk Michael Counter

Blackburn Coach

9 miles Moderate

We alight the coach at Shapbeck Bridge on the A6 which is north of Shap Village and then we follow a bridleway passing Our Scar and onto reach the top of Knipe Scar. The ridge is now followed, eventually dropping down to High Knipe and then onto Hill Plantation. A further bridle way is now followed to Whale Farm and then the hamlet of Helton is passed. The way now leads up onto Askham Fell 1100ft and crosses the old Roman road at Ketley Gate, before dropping down into Polley Bridge.

Great views of the northern Lakeland Fells as we descend (once my wish will come true and the weather [will be] kind and you will believe me).

C Walk Hannah Rose

Blackburn Coach

8 miles Moderate

Alight the coach at Lowther village. Take the lane through Lowther Newtown and the Alms house into the park at Lowther Castle. We'll pay a visit to the church with its tombs and mausoleums to the Lowthers.

After that it's over the river to the pretty village of Askham before a steepish climb over Askham Fell for hopefully fabulous views of Ullswater and Pooley Bridge.

D Walk Roger Haythornthwaite

Burnley Coach

7 miles Moderate

Alight at Askham and walk through this pretty hillside village. After a 2-mile ascent (not steep) onto Askham Fell we reach The Cockpit stone circle. From here, good views of Ullswater should be experienced.

After about a mile of levelish walking, we reach Winder Hall Farm, Celleron, Barton Church (14th Century) then paths into Pooley Bridge.
