Today's Walks

A Walk **Robert Eccles**

Starting from Eyam we're soon climbing out of the valley to Sir William Hill. Taking advantage of the Right to Roam we'll visit the stone circle on Eyam Moor before hopping over a wall and dropping down over Smelting Hill to the River Derwent. Then it's fairly random paths to Upper Padley. We climb up to Froggatt Edge and walk along it for a bit before dropping down to Froggatt Bridge. Then we're back to Eyam over fields and by the Riley Graves.

Expect some great views, 873 metres of ascent, a bit of a rough ground and a wall to vault.

B Walk Sue Baxendale

From coach park walk through the village to take path up through the woods to Edge Road, pass Mompesson's Well and on to Eyam Moor. Follow track and minor road towards Hazelford. Paths through the valley to Stoke Ford then up to Abney. Minor road to Abney Grange and then field path down to Bretton Brook followed by the final climb (steep but short) to the top of Eyam Edge. Descend to Foolow village and then field paths back to Eyam.

Some moorland, some forests, some fields, good views but not a flat walk by any means.

C Walk **Chris Thornley**

Alight on the A623 at Wardlow Mires. Follow Field paths and tracks to the village of Grindlow. Then a steep climb through a wood to Hucklow Edge. Continue on field paths to Abney Grange. Then on a quiet road to the village of Abney. Continue down Abney Clough to Stoke Ford. Then a fairly steep climb up to Stanage and Eyam Moor. Continue across Eyam Moor to Sir William Hill Road. Then field paths past Ladywash Mine. A steep descent down Beech Hurst, and into Eyam.

A classic Derbyshire Dales walk with lovely views throughout. A couple of steep climbs, but worth it for the views.

D Walk Paul Brown

From the coaches we walk down to The Square in Eyam, then follow a pleasant lane for about a mile to the village of Stoney Middleton. We then follow a rough track steeply uphill for about 1/2 mile to join a lane which takes us past the Riley Graves and eventually back to The Square. From here we walk uphill to Mompesson's Well, continue to Sir William Hill Road, then follow a quiet road and a fairly steep track downhill to return to the coaches. If it's fine there are some very good views.

Please note that when we return to The Square you may, if you wish, leave the walk and spend the afternoon looking around Eyam and learning more about its sad history.
