

N. E Lancashire Ramblers – Coach Ramble to Denbigh on Sunday 4th August 2019

After a rendezvous at the Chester services we continue to St Asaph where the A party start their walk and then on to Denbigh where the other two walks start. It is important for safety reasons that independent walkers leave details of your names and routes, and a mobile telephone number if possible, with the courier on your coach. Make sure you have a contact number.

A Walk Anthony Fleetwood - Anthony's Afternoon Adventure

Leave the coach at St Asaph and meander along to Denbigh. Route depends on weather and timing on the day.

B Walk No volunteer today

C Walk Michael Counter Moderate 8 miles

We alight the coaches at Denbigh and walk around the base of the castle to join field paths following the Clwdian Way. Further field paths are walked to arrive at the hamlet of Hen-efail. The farms of Rosa Fair, Segrwyd Ucha and Coed Acas are passed before reaching the River Ystrad which lies in a wooded valley. Dr Johnson's cottage is hidden within the trees. The way back now takes us by the old homesteads at Gwaynynog and Halch Hill until we reach Denbigh

D Walk Carol Higgins Moderate 6.5 miles

From Fenbigh we head gently upwards across fields and via the golf course to the village of Henflan with far reaching views eastwards along the way (weather permitting). At Henflan we pick up the Clwydan Way for more good views towards Denbigh castle and the surrounding landscape. Reaching the outskirts of the town we turn west and the walk takes us to Gwaynynog the home of Beatrix Potter's aunt and uncle and we head back to Denbigh via Galch Hill.

Pick up time for return journey. Returning Home: 6.00 pm from Denbigh. Blackburn coach to drop off in Darwen first and Burnley coach to drop off in Clayton le Moors first.
