COACH TRAVEL - you need to wear a face covering when boarding and leaving the coach and standing in the aisle. Once sat in your seat (with the seat belt fastened which is a legal requirement) you may remove your face covering!

We need support couriers for the two coaches for those occasions when the regular courier is not on the trip. Without couriers we may not be able to take bookings on the coach and issue tickets.

7th November - Pateley Bridge, Nidderdale

Pateley Bridge is full of tranquil charm as it nestles in the heart of Nidderdale, an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. This quaint market town in Nidderdale is a great base for exploring the surrounding countryside and the Yorkshire Dales.



The peace of this beautiful area has provided inspiration for writers and artists alike, and kept many a visitor returning year after year to enjoy the serenity.



There are lots of short walks for those wanting something shorter than our 'B-10 mile', 'C-8 mile' or 'D-6 mile' walks.

Do your own short walk! Fishpond Wood (2 miles), The Curlew Trail (3 miles), Pateley Bridge Heritage Trails (Inner trail 1 mile / Outer trail 2.5 miles), Victorian Gardens of Pateley Bridge Trail (3.75 miles or 4.75 miles), Scot Gate Ash Trail (4 miles), The Yorke's of Bewerley (5 miles), Ladies Riggs and Ashfoldside Trail (5-5 miles) [ROUTES HERE](#)

5th December - Festive Walk - Knaresborough

HOW TO BOOK

The current Ticket Price is £16 for adults (prices subject to change as we must break even on every trip). *There will be an increase for the 2022 Programme.*

Please contact - Mrs Christine Tormey 01254 236068 to make a booking or to find out more.

Cancellations - You can cancel up to 9pm on the Sunday 7 days prior to the trip. For those individuals, although there is no refund, you can carry your booking forward to one of the next two available trips but you must specify which trip when cancelling and cannot cancel a second time. NE Lancs Coach Rambles is one of the few remaining 'coach ramble areas' to offer a 'carry forward' but we may need to review this for 2022.. Most have already adopted a no refund and no carry forward policy. Please try not to cancel.

After the deadline please telephone Christine up to 6pm on the evening before the trip if you will not be turning up. Please do not give your seat to someone else without notifying us as the coach driver will only pickup the number of named passengers at each pickup point. Do not book for one pickup point and then try to get on somewhere else on the day!
