Serpentine Walks -

Many coach ramblers will be well acquainted with the charms of the Pavilion Gardens but how many have ventured across to the lesser-known Serpentine Walks? Explore this hidden spot by crossing Burlington Road (just next to the Pavilion Gardens Car Park by the Octagon) and heading down the steps at the bridge. Much quieter than the main gardens, this compact corner has its own wild flower meadow and if you explore a little further, you can visit the Serpentine Community Farm on Wednesdays and Sundays. These vintage images shared by Explore Buxton capture the magic of this secret nook.

This is the most accessible of the walks and the round trip takes around 30 minutes from Buxton Town Centre.



WALKERS - for those wanting a *self-guided walk* you can walk the surrounding countryside. **Self-Guided Hikers** - Just one suggestion but there are others! You might find a walk in the Goyt Valley here.

If you are doing a self-guided walk please supply a route, contact mobile number and the names of the people in your party to the Coach Courier or Coach Secretary. If you are a large group (more than four) please supply this a week prior to the walk if possible.



COACH RAMBLES GUIDED WALKS - The walker leaders are:

D Walk - 6+ miles - LEADER tbc

C Walk - 8 miles - LEADER tbc

B Walk - 10 miles - LEADER Tony Culverhouse, 10 miles. You will head north from Buxton to explore the moors and reservoirs of the Goyt Valley.

Note: Walk details are subject to change on the day due to the local weather conditions and other safety factors. These are at the discretion of the Walk Leader.

Please book early for BUXTON to avoid disappointment.

We will be booking a 53-seater coach. We will not be able to reserve the larger coach. Everyone is welcome but RAMBLERS MEMBERS WILL BE ABLE TO BOOK FIRST THEN NON-MEMBERS. We may need to operate a Waiting List. Last month six people on the waiting List were offered seats during the week prior to the trip. We confirm the coach size on the Monday morning following the Sunday deadline and this is too short notice to book the larger executive coach.

We have now included Child Tickets on TicketTailor. Children from Year 3 (aged 7 and above Key Stage 2) to Year 11 (aged 16 and under) will be classed as a child. 16 year olds that have left Year 11 will be classed as adults. Our walks, long days and coach journeys are not suitable for younger children.

Book for the NEXT Trip to BUXTON - 6th NOVEMBER 2022

We are now allowing Ramblers Members to book in advance of nonmembers which is the traditional way bookings were taken in previous vears.

Bookings for BUXTON cannot be carried forward to OTLEY they will be carried forward to FEBRUARY 2023.

BOOKINGS taken from 0900, Sunday, 2ND OCTOBER 2022 for RAMBLERS MEMBERS.

Non-Members can book from 0900 WEDNESDAY 12th OCTOBER.

IMPORTANT - We cannot accept cheques without a telephone booking

first. Send your cheque for £20 made payable to RA Coach Account to arrive

with Christine by post on Friday, 28th October. CHECK POSTAL STRIKE

DATES. If your cheque will not arrive in time please book online via

TicketTailor.

Christine will give you the address details and pickup time when you make your telephone booking.

Wrongly completed cheques and those without name/s, destination and pickup points on the reverse will be returned.

Please book as soon as possible and by 9pm on Sunday, 30th
October on TicketTailor.

You must book and pay in advance to reserve a seat. Bookings are provisional and seats cannot be guaranteed until <u>payment is received</u>. We operate a waiting list if tickets sell out early. You may lose your place to someone on the waiting list if your cheque does not arrive on time (see below).

Simply click on the TicketTailor image to discover our **online ticket sales** and then select your event and the correct ticket. You can book online for BUXTON & OTLEY on either the Blackburn or the Burnley coach - other events to be added for 2023.

IMPORTANT - CANCELLATIONS, NO SHOWS and PICK UPS

We ae getting a lot of **CANCELLATIONS** in the last few days before the trip and this means people on the Waiting List will have made other arrangements when we contact them so we have empty seats on the day. CANCEL AS EARLY AS YOU CAN PLEASE.

We are also getting a lot of 'NO SHOWS' - people who do not turn up on the day and do not let us know. PLEASE be at your pickup point ten minutes before your pickup time. The coach drivers have been waiting five minutes for people to show up and we only need a few of these and the coach can be delayed by 15-20 minutes at the meetup point. We will be leaving each pickup point at the allotted time and no longer waiting five minutes unless you contact us.

Please phone Christine before the trip and let her know if you will not be turning up. NO PHONE CALLS but you can msg 07599 106670 after 7:30am and before your pickup time on the morning of the trip.

We want to keep the outward journey to the meetup point to the minimum time possible. We are also removing some of the pickup points that have not been used since BEFORE August 2021 and where our regular travellers have a nearby alternative. This is for the benefit of everyone. Please email coachramblenel@gmail.com if this causes you problems and we can discuss.

Day visitors and people wishing to do a self-guided walk are welcome on coach ramble trips.

It is important for safety reasons that independent self-guided walkers leave details of your names, brief route description or map and a contact mobile number with the Coach Secretary or Coach Courier as we need this information in case of an incident. You will be given a NE Lancs Coach Ramble mobile number for use on the day.
