Are you ready for winter?

How you can help

Look out for elderly and vulnerable neighbours and if able clear paths and pavements outside your home. Park sensibly - allowing access for gritters and snow ploughs. Follow travel advice and if you must drive, make sure you have a car emergency kit.

Where possible, prepare for the impact of severe weather, eq power cuts, shortage of items, shop closures, blocked roads, flooding/property damage.

Prepare a home emergency kit:

- ✓ Torch with spare batteries (or wind-up torch)
- Radio with spare batteries (or a wind-up radio)
- ✓ Mobile phone charger/power bank (check it's charged regularly)
- Essential medication, toiletries & first aid kit
- A few days' supply of bottled water and ready-to-eat/long-life food including milk.
- Copies of important documents e.g. insurance policies, birth certificates, and passports
- ✓ Blankets/warm covers and clothing.
- Pencil/pen, paper, penknife and whistle (the latter to draw attention if required)
- ✓ Spare home and car keys
- ✓ Spare glasses or contact lenses.
- Pet food and essential item
- Formula/baby food and essentials
- Putty or repair clamp to fix burst pipes



Prepare a car emergency kit:

- A first aid kit
- Battery jump leads
- A torch and spare batteries
- ✓ Mobile phone power bank
- A map for unplanned diversions
- Blankets/foil blankets
- A reflective warning sign
- An ice scraper and de-icer
- A shovel for snow
- ✓ Warm clothes and boots
- ✓ Food and a warm drink in a flask
