Notes on the completion of the Entry Form

- 1) **Category** Enter the category letter applicable to each entry:-
- A. Textured Waterfowl (Ducks, Geese, Swans)
 - B. Bird of Prey (Eagles, Falcons, Owls etc)
 - C. Game Birds (Grouse, Partridge, Quail etc)
 - D. Sea Birds (Gulls, Terns, Auks etc) and Shore Birds (Avocets, Sandpipers, Stilts etc)
 - E. Songbirds (Kingfishers, Swallows, Woodpeckers etc)
 - F. Decorative Miniatures “Miniatures”
 - G. Interpretive Wood Sculptures “Interpretives”
 - G1 Wood which can be stained or varnished but to retain a natural appearance
 - G2 Pyrographed, Painted or a combination of both
 - H. Slick Smoothie Waterfowl
 - I. Slick Smoothie Shorebirds & Waders
 - J. Working Decoys
 - K. Fish
 - L. Carved Bird’s Head
 - M. Carved Bird’s Head on Stick
 - M1 Head carved from Wood
 - M2 Head carved from Horn
 - N. Innovative Wildlife Sculpture
 - O. Feather
- 2) **Class** Enter the class level at which you are entering:-
- 1 Novice
 - 2 Intermediate
 - 3 Advanced
 - 4 Youth
 - 5 Exhibition
- 3) **Entry No** Please leave blank
- 4) **Description** A brief description of each entry – Important, if the carving is not full-size and is not entered in the “Miniatures” category then it is essential that this is included in the description, eg ‘Half Size Mallard Drake’
- 5) **Sex** Enter M (male) or F (female)
- 6) **Result** Please leave blank
- 7) **Carver** Please leave blank
- 8) **Fee** Enter the appropriate fee
