an optional climb up Drumcarrow Craig so we carried on towards Denhead. After following the woodland path beside the Duke's golf course we headed for Craigtoun Park and our lunch stop, where we were joined by two more of our group for the final 3 miles to St Andrews. The going was mostly downhill after this, through the welcome shade of Lumbo Den and then on to the Lade Braes. On reaching the town centre we adjourned for refreshments at a favourite café – the perfect conclusion to a lovely walk.
