We had lunch under the trees and then retraced our steps towards Cupar via Woodlands Farm, Owlet Wood and the Moor Road. After this pleasant, leisurely walk we rounded off the afternoon with a visit to a well-known café, where your correspondent made herself less than popular by commandeering the last available cheese scone.
