Last week St Andrews and North East Fife Ramblers had a good turnout of fourteen for a leisurely 4-mile circular walk from Boarhills, skirting around Kittocks Golf Course and returning along the coastal path. This was a change to the walk originally planned, as the intended route had proved impassable when recced – something of a recurring theme for our walk leaders this summer! Setting out from the village under an overcast sky, we stopped shortly afterwards to admire the newly-renovated doocot before making our way towards the golf course. There we followed tracks leading to the Fairmont Hotel and then



descended a narrow path to join the coastal path. We made this our lunch stop, enjoying pleasant views out to sea and just making out the spires of St Andrews through the haze. We continued past the distinctive Buddo Rock, carefully negotiating this quite challenging stretch of the coastal path which is often narrow, undulating and with many steps. Our route then took us inland again along a farm track and we arrived back in Boarhills just as the sun finally emerged.
